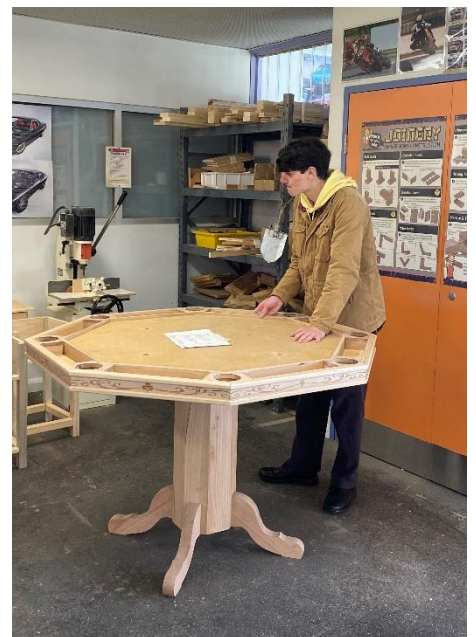

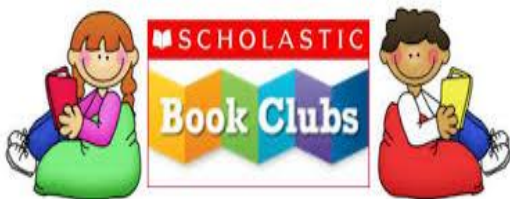
P&C Meeting
