The students love that what they do are like maths games, but they are secretly learning... 🤫 Shhhh 😊

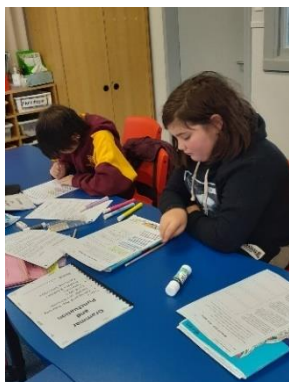


YEAR 5/6 NEWS

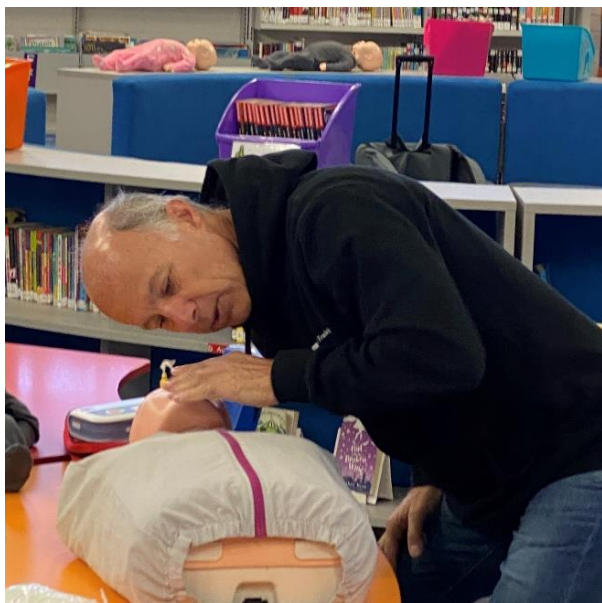


