In Rhythm to Recovery with Kids Xpress we have been using drums and other instruments. We sit in a circle and someone uses the big drum to keep the heart beat sound and when that person is ready to stop they count down from four. We use different patterns to make sound.

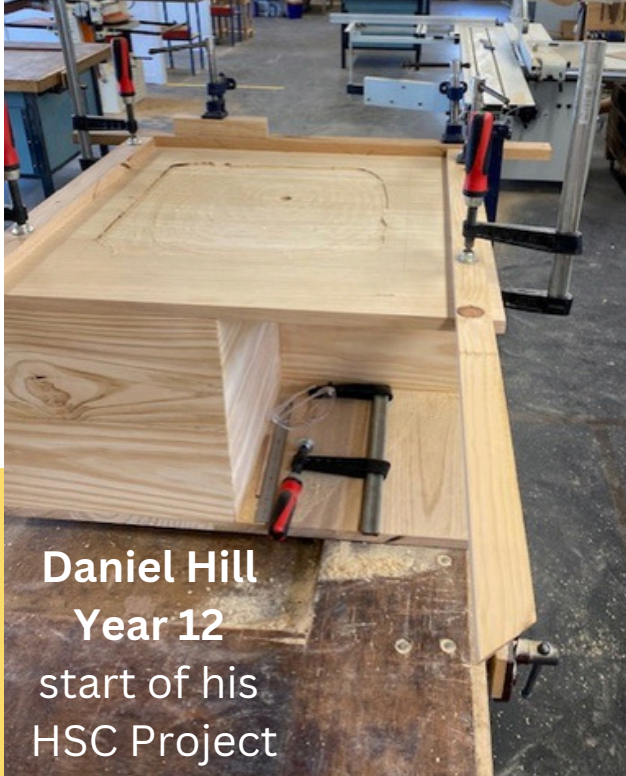
